



TOWN OF WINDSOR BYLAW # 06 TOWN SEAL AND CREST BYLAW

- 06.01** The common seal of the Town made of metal in the year 1953 and having engraved thereon a castle, cornucopia, helmet and other figures and words “Seal of the Town of Windsor 1878” is and shall continue to be seal of the Town.
- 06.02** Any person requiring the Mayor or Town Clerk to affix the seal to any proper certificate or document for the purpose of the authentication of the same shall pay to the Town the sum of Five Dollars therefore which sum shall be paid into and form a part of the general revenues of the Town.
- 06.03** The Town of Windsor hereby adopts an official Town Crest which may be affixed to property and to all official documents and correspondence of the Town.
- 06.04** The official Town Crest shall be as shown below and described as follows: “Vert, a castle or, on a chief argent a cornucopia vert, fructed or Crest: a helmeted head of Athena or Motto ‘E Terra Abundantia’”.
