



TOWN OF WINDSOR BYLAW # 01 INTERPRETATION

- 01.01** The Council of the Town of Windsor pursuant and by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by the Legislature of the Province of Nova Scotia does make and publish the following By-laws:
- 01.02** In these By-laws unless the context otherwise requires
- (a) Clerk means the Town Clerk of the Town of Windsor.
 - (b) Chief Administrative Officer means the Chief Administrative Officer of the Town of Windsor.
 - (c) Council means the Town Council of the Town of Windsor.
 - (d) Mayor means the Mayor of the Town of Windsor.
 - (e) Presiding Councillor includes the Deputy Mayor or any Councillor acting as chair at a meeting of the Town Council or any meeting called pursuant to the Towns Act.
 - (f) Any time referred to in these By-laws shall mean Atlantic Standard Time unless Atlantic Daylight Time is in effect in the Province in which case it shall refer to Atlantic Daylight Time.
 - (g) Town means the Town of Windsor.
 - (h) Towns Act means the Towns Act R.S.N.S. 1989 Chapter 472 and any amendments thereto.
 - (i) Quorum means a majority of the members of Council or a committee, board or commission of the Council as the case may be.
