



## TOWN OF WINDSOR

### RESOLUTION RESPECTING ELECTION SIGNS POLICY

**Whereas**, municipal, provincial and federal elections do take place from time to time; and,

**Whereas**, candidates are allowed to post campaign signs within the Town limits; and,

**Whereas**, campaign signs have occasionally been placed in inappropriate places so that the greatest prominence and visibility of the sign is achieved; and

**Whereas**, the installation of campaign signs have been knowingly or unwittingly installed on town-owned sign structures;

**Now therefore, be it resolved** that the Town of Windsor reminds all potential candidates that:

1. Campaign signs are restricted to private property (with the permission of the property owner)
2. Campaign signs are not to be installed within the Town's street right of way;
3. Campaign signs are not to be a safety hazard or obstruct the view of traffic at intersections and driveways;
4. Campaign signs or messages are not to be installed on utility poles, town posts, town trees or town-owned assets. This includes any message board signs on town property;

Be it further resolved that any signs or campaign literature installed in violation of this Council Policy or any signs posing a safety hazard to the public will be removed at the candidate's expense.
