Q: I would like to know how the plans are going for the arena?

A:

- Approx. 3 yrs ago a proposal was submitted by the Long Pond Heritage Society to build a Hockey Heritage Centre (an arena, but one that also encompasses the hockey heritage history of Windsor).
- Over those years, the proposal (the actual physical facility) has changed some as a result of public input and public consultations, but the location remained in the same location, up by Long Pond. (The structure has changed because of many factors, i.e. financial, what it would encompass, size, etc). There were funding sources acknowledged for this project.
- Within the past seven months, another proposal came forward to have an arena/hockey heritage centre type facility built on the Agricultural Grounds.
- At this time, the Federal and Provincial governments are undertaking a feasibility study to assess the economic impact a Hockey Heritage Centre would provide to the community and an assessment of each site proposal so that the Councils can then pick a location.
