MAXIMUM of 4 bags per collection (bag #1 & bag #2 combined)

Clean & Dry

Newspapers
Paper, including shredded
Boxboard (eg: cereal and tissue boxes)
Paper egg cartons
Flyers
Magazines
Catalogues
Envelopes
File folders
Paperbacks
Phonebooks
Toilet paper cores
Hard cover books (covers removed placed in garbage)
Paper carry-out trays
Paper bags

Corrugated cardboard

- Flattened
- Bundled no larger than 1'x2'x3'
- 2 bundles per collection

No Pizza Boxes

No metal clips, hangers, or coiled spirals

Rinse & Clean Remove Lids/Caps

* Juice cartons
* Beer, wine & liquor bottles
* Pop bottles & cans
* Water bottles
Glass bottles and jars
Aluminum/steel/tin cans
Aluminum pie plates/trays
All milk containers
Plastic bags (bread, grocery & shopping)
Stretch wrap for freight
Plastic bottles, jars & containers
Shampoo & conditioner bottles
Cleaning bottles (nozzles removed)
Plastic containers, #1-7
Cereal & cracker box liners

* **Ready-to-Serve beverage containers (excluding milk) can be returned to any Enviro-Depot for a refund.**

Food & Kitchen Scraps

* Fruits & vegetables
* Baked goods
* Rice, grains & pasta
* Egg shells
* Tea bags
* Coffee grounds & filters
* Table & food scraps
Cooking oil & fat
Meat, fish, shellfish, poultry or bones
Solid dairy products (removed from packaging)

Soiled Paper:

* Food napkins & tissues
* Paper towels
Paper sugar, flour and potato bags
Paper plates
Parchment Paper
Pizza boxes

Yard Waste:

* Leaves, brush & grass clippings
* House & garden plant waste
Sawdust and wood shavings

* **These items can also be put in a Backyard Composter**

4 bags and 1 bulky item* per collection

Aluminum foil, soiled
Small appliances (iron, toaster)
Clothing & Textiles (you can also donate these)
Diapers & wipes
Used tissue

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

Fluorescent tubes, aerosol cans, batteries, battery acid, chemical strippers, bleach, propane tanks, antifreeze, and other chemicals

- Not acceptable curbside
- Must be taken directly to the HHW Facility at the landfill.

Location: 1569 Walton Woods Rd, Cogmagun

Hours of operation: Monday to Friday: 8am-5pm; Saturday: 8-1

Carts containing any plastic, glass, Styrofoam™, metals, pet waste, or other non-compostable materials will not be collected.

* **Bulky Items:** Sofa, table, mattress, toilet, sink, vacuum cleaner, desk, etc.

Broken Glass must be boxed and clearly labeled 'Glass' and placed with regular garbage

Cell phones may be recycled at the Town office 100 King St. **Remove the phone chip**

Most electronics can be taken to the EPRA drop-off centre New Boundaries on Centennial Drive

Safe Sharps Program: Contact your pharmacy for disposal of medical sharps and expired medications

Leaf & Yard Waste

Collection is on the last Monday of the month
April to November ONLY

- Brush/branches must be bundled & tied and no longer than 3.5 ft
- **ONLY 2 bundles per collection**
- Limbs smaller than 3" round
- Clear, transparent or orange bags
- Does not exceed 25kg (55 lbs.)

Metal Collection

Collection is twice per year

- Items must be larger than 1 ft²
- At least 70% metal
- Oil tanks must be empty and cut in half
- Washer, water tanks, BBQs, lawn mowers
- Fridge, A/C unit, freezers must have 'CFC Removed' sticker

Construction &

Demolition Debris

- Not accepted curbside
- Take directly to the landfill, located at 1569 Walton Woods Rd, Cogmagun

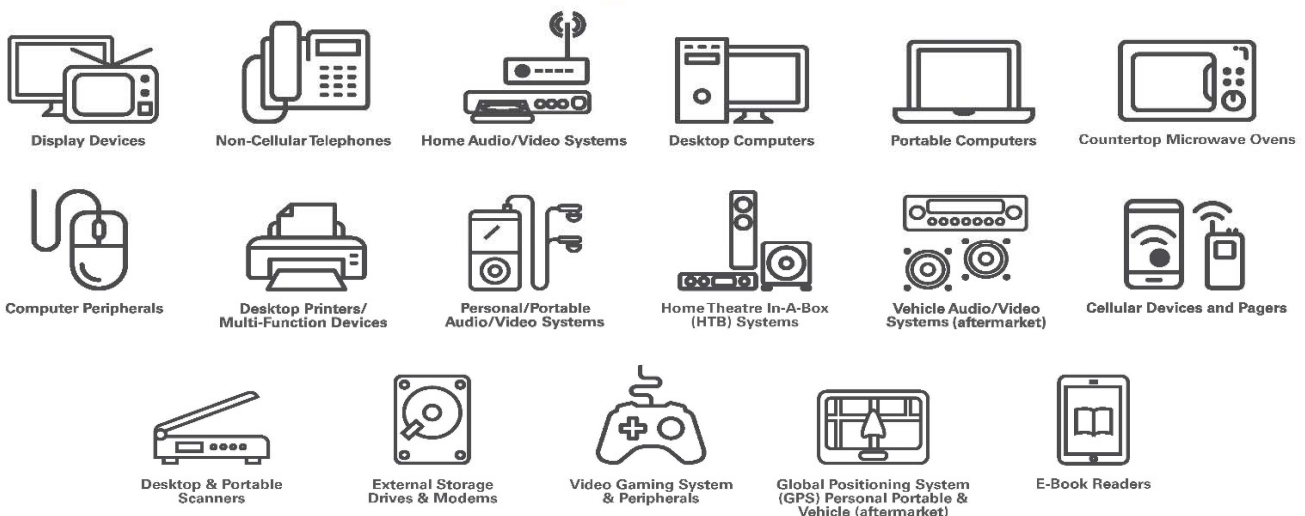

Wednesday: Albert Street (Civics 32-335), Avon Street, Cedar Street, Chestnut Street, Cobbett Street, Colonial Drive, Fort Edward Street, Fox Lane, Gerrish Street, Gray Street, Hawthorne Street, King Street (Civics 8-467), King Street Extension, Munroe Street, Nesbitt Street, Stannus Street, Thomas Street, Victoria Lane, Victoria Street, Wagners Court, Water Street, and Wiley Avenue (Civics 155-257).
