PUBLIC HEARING and SECOND READING AMENDED SOLID WASTE BYLAW # 16

Pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act;

PUBLIC HEARING & SECOND READING of the **PROPOSED AMENDED SOLID WASTE BYLAW #16** will occur at the Windsor Town Council meeting on **Tuesday, October 22, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. in Windsor Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, 100 King Street, Windsor, NS.**

* **NOTE** * During the public hearing, there is opportunity for public to speak in-favour of or opposed to the proposed bylaw. Further, should you wish, you may provide your written input up until 12:00 P.M. AUTHORITY OF PROPOSED BYLAW:

- **Municipal Government Act** Part VII, Power to make Bylaws, Section 172(1)(c) and Part XIII, Solid Waste Resource Management – Bylaw Regarding Solid Waste, Section 325.
- **Solid Waste – Resource Management Regulations** made under Section 102 of the Environment Act (effective February 6, 2019), N.S. Reg. 26/2019 – Part III – Litter Abatement – Prohibition against littering, Section 19(a), (b) and (c).

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENTS TO THE PROPOSED BYLAW INCLUDE:

- Preamble altered to identify this amended bylaw, if approved would be effective upon publication;
- Legislative Authority includes the Solid Waste-Resource Management Regulations;
- 16.01(7) - removed size and manufacturer of the “compostainer”;
- 16.01(16) - added definition of “litter” as defined in the Solid Waste-Resource Management Regulations;
- Everywhere the original bylaw indicated “Director of Public Works,” “Solid Waste Manager,” and/or “Town of Windsor Engineer,” replaced it with “Designate”;
- 16.02 updated Solid Waste Management Facilities to include “GFL Environmental”
- 16.22(3) – Changed the time from midnight to 11:00 pm for clarity as midnight could refer to midnight same day or following day. Also shortened 16.22 and created a new Section 16.23;
- 16.23 – new section; much of which was from previous 16.22 but now includes details of the Town of Windsor’s Solid Waste Policy;
- 16.23(8) – increased the size permitted for bulky items to allow for mattress/boxspring, couches;
- 16.26 – 16.30 – Removed from original and not replaced with anything as per suggestion of Solicitor;
- 16.35 - Removed
- 16.36 and 16.37 – Reversed as per suggestion of Solicitor;
- With all the mentioned changes, the proposed bylaw has been re-numbered accordingly (where there were additions/removal of sections).
